The general objective of this meeting is to present the results of the analysis of the acute food and nutrition insecurity situation for the period of October to December 2025 and June to August 2026.

More specifically, it is to present the results on:

- Identification of areas at risk based on the current (October-December 2025) and projected (June-August 2026) food and nutrition insecurity severity classification scale of the 27 states and the FCT analyzed;
- Mapping of the areas identified by food and nutrition insecurity phase;
- Estimation of populations by phase of food and nutrition insecurity severity during the current and projected period.





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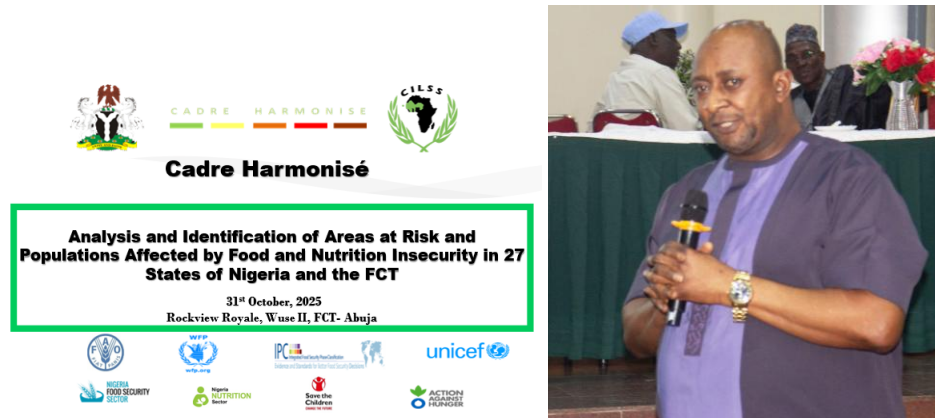

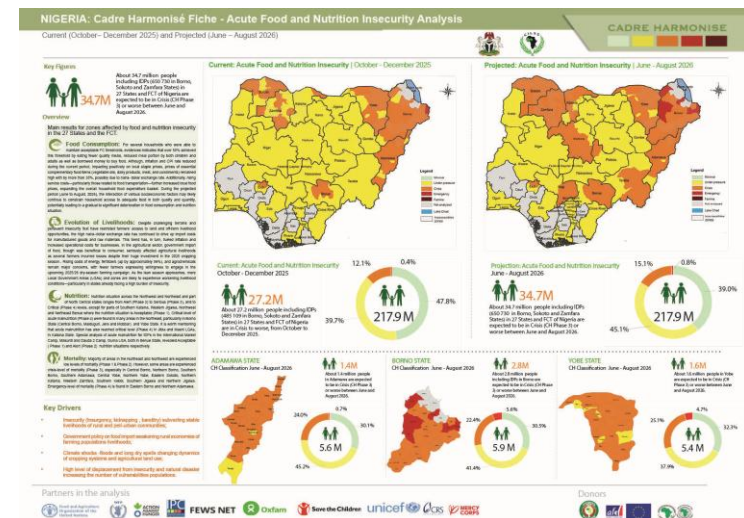
